Vintage Art Deco Chandelier, c.1930

This five-light fixture features a black fluted column, adorned with angel wings in antique brass. The iridescent glass shades are original to this fixture and are decorated with compass-like stars. In its day, this style of lighting was considered very modern.



Vintage Dancing Muses Pendant, c.1935

This gorgeous bronze pendant captures the essence of rare vintage lighting with its ornate details and unique design. Made in Italy with a madrigal influence, this pendant features cast bronze dancing muses in flowing tunics with tambourines and batons. These beautiful ladies alternate with frosted panels of glass, framed in cast bronze.

Vintage Art Nouveau Painted Floor Lamp, c.1925

This vintage floor lamp features a beautiful twisted tube with a painted metal finish, artichoke breaks and a pierced base. It is signed by the famous Salem Brothers and has been carefully restored to its original beauty with new electrical components by the skilled craftsmen at Restoration Lighting Gallery.

Stamped June 18th, 1878, this original Bradley & Hubbard oil lamp conversion features intricately cast cameos, a floral motif, twisted rope brass column and three cast iron legs. To keep its originality, a three-way touch dimmer was installed rather than a switch; the lamp can be turned off, on or dimmed by a gentle touch anywhere on the lamp. It is outfitted with a retro style shade that is hand made in the USA.

Custom Lighthouse Fixture

This fixture was inspired by a customer who fell in love with a lighthouse while on vacation in Portland, Oregon. By working with the skilled craftsmen at Restoration Lighting Gallery, she was able to bring her memory home. Vintage Slag Glass Partners Lamp, c.1910

This beautiful desk lamp is made for two! It has two separate lights, each with an individual pull-chain which are bolstered onto the column with antique brass rods. It has two flawless original slag glass shades with blue, green and yellow tones, creating the backdrop for a metal overlay of a cabin scene with trees and a lakeside view. The column is decorated in a classical style and flows down to a detailed base with various designs and accents.
